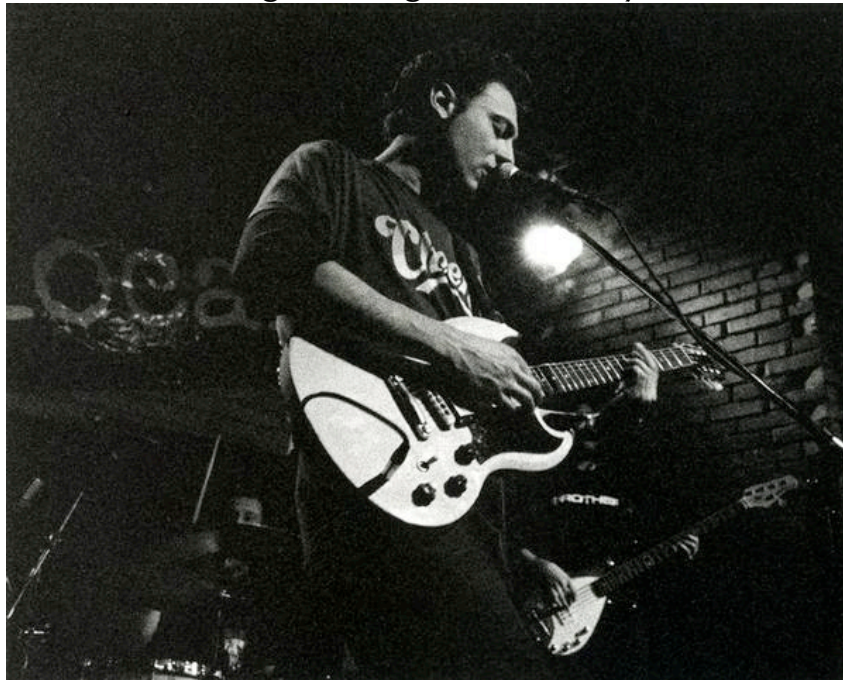


Massimo Giangrande

Singer, guitar player, songwriter, producer, Massimo Giangrande forms in 1998 the band Punch & Judy, which gets to publish the album *La Cura Migliore* in 2004.

He's artistic producer of the cd *Orchidea Porpora* with [Lara Martelli](#), whom he participates to the [Jeff Buckley](#) tribute (Chicago, 2002) with. His interest for electronic sounds takes him to collaborating as singer and guitar player to the project M.V.B.H. with Massimo Evangelisti.

In 2005 he's bass player for the album *Acqua, Luce e Gas* by [Pino Marino](#); the same year, he's on guitar for [Tiromancino](#) during the *Illusioni Parallele Tour*. He also writes music for theatre: *Zero* by Massimiliano Bruno and *Ancora un attimo* with [Paola Cortellesi](#). He's now working as producer for the singer [Awa Ly](#) and he's part of the [Collettivo Angelo Mai](#).

His first solo cd, *Apnea*, is being released.



Athebustop is Italian singer/songwriter Claudio Donzelli. After playing with [Mondayontv](#) (from 1998 to 2005), he decided to start this solo project in order

to find a new outlet for a creative burst of introspective song-writing. In 2006 he successfully participated to important contests like the Heineken Jammin Festival, the Neapolis Festival, and the Trofeo Bar Wolf, getting to play in more important venues.

At the end of 2006, Claudio met Matteo Gamberini (singer/songwriter known as [August in Fall](#)) and hit the road with him during the *All by Myself* tour, a series of shows around Italy and other European countries, where both artists presented their own projects and shared the stage for newly arranged covers, also participating to *Panoplie Italian Nights* festival on June 2007.

This experience gave a more definite shape to his project. Currently, Athebustop is working on his debut album.
